Yes. Just note there will be some shifts in approach and style in the other option.

On the regional level, will there be a parity between Battalion units that use one or the other approach?

Yes. There should be complete equality, as young men will be advancing through the same ranks.

Are the Observer and Herald of Christ requirements the same for both versions?

Yes. Both **Observer** and **Herald of Christ** will have the same content.
