

Builder Trails — Trail Signs (ESV)

Blockhouse 1

- Deuteronomy 6:5 — “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.”
- 1 John 4:19 — “We love because he first loved us.”
- Psalm 23:6 — “Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.”
- 1 Samuel 3:10 — “And the Lord came and stood, calling as at other times, ‘Samuel! Samuel!’ And Samuel said, ‘Speak, for your servant hears.’”

Blockhouse 2

- Romans 3:23 — “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”
- Romans 6:23 — “For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”
- Romans 5:8 — “But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”
- Romans 10:9-10 — “If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”

Blockhouse 3

- Genesis 22:8 — “Abraham said, “God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son.” So they went both of them together.”
- John 1:29 — “The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, “Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!”
- 1 Peter 2:24 — “He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.”
- Revelation 5:12 — “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!”

Blockhouse 4

- Genesis 45:5 — “And now do not be distressed or angry with yourselves because you sold me here, for God sent me before you to preserve life.”
- Ephesians 4:32 — “Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.”
- Proverbs 15:1 — “A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.”
- Proverbs 16:32 — “Whoever is slow to anger is better than the mighty, and he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.”

Blockhouse 5

- Acts 16:30–31 — “Then he brought them out and said, ‘Sirs, what must I do to be saved?’ And they said, ‘Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household.’”
- Philippians 2:3–4 — “Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.”
- Ephesians 6:1–3 — “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ‘Honor your father and mother’ (this is the first commandment with a promise).”
- Galatians 6:10 — “So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.”

Blockhouse 6

- Jeremiah 1:7 — “But the Lord said to me, ‘Do not say, ‘I am only a youth’; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak.’”
- 2 Timothy 3:16 — “All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,”
- Psalm 119:11 — “I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.”
- Psalm 40:8 — “I delight to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart.”

Blockhouse 7

- Joshua 1:9 — “Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”
- Daniel 6:22 — “My God sent his angel and shut the lions’ mouths, and they have not harmed me, because I was found blameless before him; and also before you, O king, I have done no harm.”
- Matthew 5:16 — “In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

Blockhouse 8

- Matthew 6:9–10 — “Pray then like this: ‘Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.’”
- Philippians 4:6 — “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.”

- Mark 11:25 — “And whenever you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone, so that your Father also who is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.”

Sentinel Trails — Trail Signs (ESV)

Station 1

- Jonah 3:5 — “And the people of Nineveh believed God. They called for a fast and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them to the least of them.”
- 1 John 5:11-12 — “And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.”
- 1 Peter 1:3 — “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.”
- Romans 8:1-2 — “There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.”

Station 2

- John 13:34-35 — “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.”
- 1 John 5:11-12 — “And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.”
- Romans 8:28 — “And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.”
- 1 Samuel 20:4 — “Then Jonathan said to David, ‘Whatever you say, I will do for you.’”

Station 3

- 2 Timothy 4:11 — “Luke alone is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is very useful to me for ministry.”
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 — “Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”
- Hebrews 10:24-25 — “And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.”
- James 1:2-3 — “Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness.”

Station 4

- Mark 13:31 — “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away.”
- 2 Kings 22:11 — “When the king heard the words of the Book of the Law, he tore his clothes.”
- Colossians 3:16 — “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.”
- 2 Timothy 2:15 — “Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.”

Station 5

- Isaiah 9:6 — “For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”
- 2 Chronicles 7:14 — “If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”
- Mark 1:17-18 — “And Jesus said to them, ‘Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men.’ And immediately they left their nets and followed him.”
- Hebrews 11:6 — “And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.”

Station 6

- Mark 10:44-45 — “And whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”
- 1 Timothy 4:12 — “Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.”
- Mark 7:15 — “There is nothing outside a person that by going into him can defile him, but the things that come out of a person are what defile him.”
- Philippians 4:7 — “And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”
- Mark 8:35 — “For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and the gospel’s will save it.”

Station 7

- Hebrews 4:12 — “For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.”
- John 1:1 — “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”
- Luke 2:52 — “And Jesus increased in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man.”
- Revelation 4:11 — “Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.”
- Mark 12:30-31 — “And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’ 31 The second is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”

Station 8

- John 14:27 — “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.”
- John 14:2-3 — “In my Father’s house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also.”
- Mark 16:19 — “So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.”
- Revelation 22:20 — “He who testifies to these things says, ‘Surely I am coming soon.’ Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!”
- 2 Timothy 2:22 — “So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.”
