



As the Chief Ranger... How Do I Choose a Stockade Module?

Understanding the purpose of a Stockade "Module" is essential.

• Each Module is a leader's ready-made resource for unlocking the Stockade experience.

 Each Module has quality prepared material on a subject of interest to pre-teen boys. There is a broad range of subjects coupled with appropriate Scripture.

• Each Module has ideas for use in every major aspect (Post Meetings, Games, Stockade Action, Story Circle) of four Stockade meetings.

• There are two components for each Module: the Leader's Guide and an Outpost Adventure (to be completed by each Stockader for credit in his Achievement progress).

• Each Module has a color code and reinforces one of four growth aspects given in Luke 2:52:

 Wisdom – Red guides, focus on mental growth (example: Electricity)

 Stature – Green guides, focus on physical growth (example: Siege Weapons)

 Favor with God – Yellow guides, focus on spiritual growth (example: Light)

 Favor with Man – Blue guides, focus on social growth (example: Bikes and Boards)

In the process of planning Stockade meetings, discuss with the leadership team which of the Stockade Modules seems to be a possible good fit. Having the entire leadership team on board and enthused will be a major factor in its success. Choose a variety of color codes in a given year. Modules are not meant as a substitute for personal achievement; but they serve as a helpful supplement.

All Post Rangers should have a copy of the Module being used, and each boy should receive its Outpost Adventure booklet.
